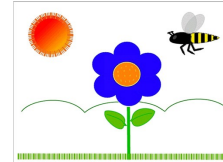

## TANGENT FIRE CHIEF RETIRING

Tangent Fire Chief Scott Casebolt will be retiring the end of June 2018 after five years of outstanding service with our Fire District. As Chief, his daily pledge has always been to improve emergency response and fire education to our community; and to this end, the District has benefited greatly from his many accomplishments.

During his tenure with Tangent, the Fire District was awarded OFDDA (Oregon Fire District Directors Assn.) Fire District of the Year for 2015. Over the years, the Chief has added several newer pieces of apparatus (water tenders, engine, command and staff rigs) to our fleet. Building projects have included creation of a new classroom in the old bay; remodel of the upstairs classroom into 3 bedrooms, a kitchen, and dayroom; buildout of two new offices in the old Board room; and new siding/windows/paint/flooring in the main station. He added a third staff position to provide better prevention and education programs for our community and created a Support Team for rehab at major incidents and assistance with District functions. The Chief also wrote and received numerous grants to purchase security cameras and lighting on the station grounds, wildland gear for our volunteers, a commercial washer/dryer for heavy turnouts, and a new door-lock system for the station. And, in an effort to increase transparency with our constituents, he created a District Website and Facebook Page.

Always an advocate of trying to do more with fewer resources, Casebolt collaborated with Lebanon and Albany Fire Departments to house a staffed ambulance in Tangent for the purposes of 1) providing a central location for the three departments to deliver faster medical assistance to our patrons in the local area; and 2) providing more expedient transfer of patients to various regional medical facilities.

As part of the Fire Service pomp and circumstance, in which he so strongly believes, he created the Linn Benton Fire Service Honor Guard and the Central Willamette Public Safety Pipe Band (he is an outstanding bagpiper whose services are frequently requested at various county and state functions).

Prior to his service with Tangent Fire, Casebolt worked 33 years with Tacoma Fire in many different roles. He also served on several FEMA Disaster incidents—Northridge California earthquake in 1994, Atlanta Olympics in 1996, and New York City where he spent 10 days digging through the ruins of what was once the World Trade Center for survivors after the 9/11 attacks.

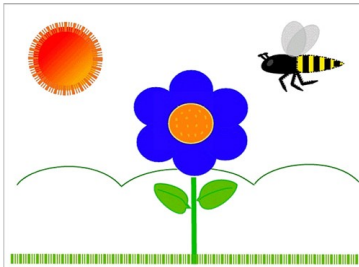
