City Improvements

WALKING PATH

We have a new walking path from Tangent Drive to Wildrose Drive! This walkway is called the David E. Brush Memorial Pathway and was partially funded by Oregon Parks and Recreation Department with the City paying for the remainder. The funding the City provided was from the SDC Fund where money is saved for projects such as this. We hope you will have a chance to check out this walkway and hope in the future to be able to add more paths throughout the city.

CROSSWALK

The Oregon Department of Transportation awarded the City funds to put in the Crosswalk, just north of Tangent Drive, and south of North Lake Creek Drive to provide a safe way to cross Highway 99E. This crosswalk will have lights that will be activated when someone needs to cross the street. This is expected to have been completed by the end of November.

Cougar Siting

On Tuesday, November 13, Tangent City Hall received a call from a concerned citizen who had just sited a young cougar at the tree line running parallel to the David E. Brush Memorial Park. This new walking/biking path begins at the end of Wildrose Street, crosses Birdfoot Drive, and continues on to Tangent Drive. The siting of the cougar was between Birdfoot Drive and Tangent Drive. The City called Oregon Fish & Wildlife after the Linn County Sheriff's Office directed them to and staff was sent a poster with cougar facts, hiking tips, and encounter tips as well as contact information for ODFW. We have included that poster with this newsletter and it is also posted at each end of the park.
