## Time To Mow

Please remember to mow your tall grass. Any grass or other vegetation that is taller than 10 inches needs to be cut and removed from the property they own or use. Failing to comply may result in the property being called a fire hazard and nuisance, which could mean a fine for every day the property has remained in a hazardous condition. All dead bushes, dead trees, stumps, dry brush, dry vegetation, ladder fuel and any other material that could cause, spread, or fuel fire must be eliminated. Thank you!
