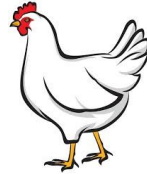

New Animal Ordinance

The City Council has received several complaints, about roosters in particular and other poultry. The new ordinance does not permit poultry to run loose upon any public property. There is a limit on the number of poultry allowed, which is **NO ROOSTERS**, 12 pigeons, and two of any other kind of poultry. Chicks under the age of four months shall not count towards the maximum number allowed. Additionally, all poultry shall be kept in a fenced enclosure at all times. In the evening they shall be put into their coop or chicken house and shall have access to it during the day. Outdoor enclosures shall be adequately fenced to contain the poultry and prevent access to the poultry by dogs or other predators.



Please Take Care of Your Animals

We have had several complaints about animals wandering into other people's yards, causing concerns and minor damage. These animals range from domestic rabbits and chickens to goats and sheep. If you have animals, it is your obligation to make sure they are in a fenced area. This is for the safety of your animals as well as other people's property.
